

SATURDAY NIGHT FEVER (A)

(reclassified from 'X' to 'A')

- Reel 1 Remove boy's dialogue in the car referring to drugs, "3 downers, 2 blues," etc.
Remove sight of pill jar as boys sit at the disco table, and dialogue reference to "speed".
- Reel 2 Remove opening section of staircase sequence, reducing dialogue between Tony and Annette, "Maybe I'll make it with you," "We'll do it." "If we were making it."
In Stephanie's line in the dance rehearsal room, "I bet it begins with a 'c', Mr P," delete the words, "'c', Mr P."
Remove further reference to speed at disco table before Tony dances with plump blonde.
- Reel 4 Reduce dialogue where girl approaches Tony in the disco and asks twice, "Are you as good in bed as you are on the dance floor?" plus dialogue by Tony's friend, "He never made it in a bed."
Remove the second of Annette's dialogue lines to Tony in the disco, "We could make it now."
Remove Tony's dialogue to Annette in the back of the car, "Are you on the pill, the IOU, the diaphragm?" etc, leaving one brief scene to establish his disenchantment.
- Reel 5 When Bobby questions Stephanie about marriage or abortion, reduce references to abortion by shortening the scene.
Remove close shot of Annette's hand holding packets of contraceptives.
Remove sight of boy holding up a flick-knife as he stands outside the pool hall.

- Reel 5
(Cont'd) Reduce the gang fight, in particular the heavier impact blows.
Remove Annette's dialogue line, "Give me another of those ... I like them, they're good ..." referring to pills.
- Reel 6
Reduce Annette's hysteria on bridge.
Delete sight of Bobby's body hitting the water.
